**WORKING PAPER**

Subject: **INTERVIEW FOR POSTING OF OFFICIALS IN INFORMATION SECTIONS ABROAD**

This Wing has initiated the process of selecting officials, against sanctioned posts of 15 APS (BS 16), 7 Steno Typists (BS 16), and 18 Assistants (BS 16), for posting in Information Sections Abroad. Detail of positions and stations is placed at F/A.

2. The process for selection has been initiated as per policy promulgated through Executive Order, dated 17.11.2006 (F/B) in the pretext of Federal Services Tribunal's Order, dated 10.04.2023, which states: *"The policy promulgated through executive order, dated 17.11.2006, is intact and has to be followed. Consequently, the appellants and the staff as described in the executive order referred to above are eligible for consideration of selection in the information sections abroad accordingly by the Committee mentioned in the executive order."*

3. In compliance with the above-referred Orders passed by FST, all officials of BS 14 – BS 16 from the Ministry, Press Information Department, Directorate of Electronic Media and Publications, and Information Service Academy were considered. After shortlisting 206 officials were called for written test. However, out of 206 eligible officials 123 officials appeared for the written test on 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2024. Result for the written Test has been announced and eighty four (84) officials have passed. Merit-wise list of officials with their scores/marks in written test placed at F/C.

4. The division of Marks is as follows:

a. Written Test	70 Marks
b. ACRs	15 Marks
c. Interview	15 Marks
<b>Total</b>	<b>100 Marks</b>

5. In its meeting to be held on 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2024, the Departmental Selection Committee will award marks to the candidates, according to the enclosed Performa (F/D). The marks awarded will have **15 % weightage** in the overall grading.

**EXECUTIVE ORDER**


**Subject: - POSTING OF STAFF OF THE MINISTRY AND ITS ATTACHED DEPARTMENTS/WINGS IN THE INFORMATION SECTIONS OF PAKISTAN'S MISSIONS ABROAD**

In exercise of powers under Rule-5 (5, 8 : a) of Rules of Business, 1973 read with President's Two Executive Orders (20 September, 1990 and 10 June, 1992) conveyed by M/o Law and Justice, the following policy decisions have been taken with immediate effect on the above-noted subject with the approval of the Minister for Information and Broadcasting: -

- a. The operation of Wafaqi Mohtasib Secretariat's First Findings (11-01-2000) is upheld.
- b. The operation of Wafaqi Mohtasib Secretariat's Second Findings (15-02-2006) is held in abeyance in the light of the President's Executive Order dated 10<sup>th</sup> of June, 1992.
- c. All staff members (BS 01 – BS 16) working in PID (including AIOs and IAs), DFP, ISA, EP-Wing, IP-Wing, ABC, Cyber Wing, Admin Wing of the Ministry including staff of the Minister, MOS, Parliamentary Secretary, Secretary and Additional Secretary (including Assistant-in-Charge/Superintendents/Private Secretaries) shall be eligible for consideration and selection against staff posts in the Information Sections abroad. However, if the selected official is in higher grade than the post selected for, he shall have to give an undertaking/option to work against a lower post. The selection shall be made purely on merit and seniority-cum-fitness basis.
- d. M/o Information's Departmental Selection Committee is permanently regrouped and notified as under: -
  - a. DG-EP ; Chairman.
  - b. DG-PID OR his representative (BS-19) : Member
  - c. JS-A OR his representative (BS-19) : Member.
  - d. DG-IP OR his representative (BS-19) : Member.
- e. Previous selection recommended by DG-EP on 09<sup>th</sup> October, 2006 stands cancelled and of no legal effect.
- f. The entire selection procedure should be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2006.
